Board of Selectmen Budget Work Session Meeting Minutes November 15, 2022

Present: James Bailey, Chairman; Iris Campbell, Selectwoman; Richard Pelletier, Selectman; Laura Buono, Town Administrator

In Attendance: Robing Payson, Ernie Butler, Ken Stafford, Riche' Colcombe

Chairman Bailey called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

1. LAND USE PROPOSED BUDGET

Robyn Payson presented the Planning Office budget touching upon some of the differences from last year.

- A. Legal expenses increased by \$5,000 because of increased usage.
- B. A large format printer has been added in the amount of \$899, the cost for ink is \$289.
- C. GIS Line includes the cost for (2) classes one for \$1,640 and the other for \$2,400.

2. WAGE INCREASES & HEALTH INSURANCE

Ms. Buono explained all the budgets have a 2.5% cost of living increase for non-union and depending on the union contracts. There are also step increases included as well. Ms. Buono also used 5.5% increase for health insurance as of July 1st. Selectman Pelletier asked how much do the employees contribute toward health insurance? The answer was 11%. Ms. Buono explained the wage increase process to Selectman Pelletier.

3. FIRE DEPARTMENT PROPOSED BUDGET

Fire Chief, Ken Stafford presented his budget pointing out the differences.

- A. Contract Services is showing a \$5,839 increase based on per capita.
- B. Payroll is increased because of needed adjustments.
- C. Chief Stafford and Ms. Buono explained the capital reserves and equipment purchases to Selectman Pelletier.

4. <u>HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT PROPOSED BUDGET</u>

Road Agent, Ernie Butler presented his budget highlights.

- A. There is one big reduction in this budget because a piece of equipment was paid off under the Equipment Lease line.
- B. Quotes for a 10-wheeler are being considered.
- C. Prices have been gathered for the East Washington Road bridge. At the end of this year the Town will be receiving \$212K for bridge aid. Another \$60K will be needed from taxation.

5. CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Bailey moved to approve the Consent Agenda for November 15, 2022. Motion was seconded by Selectwoman Campbell. A vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously.

6. SIDEWALKS

There are some materials for the sidewalk that will need to be decided upon. Ms. Buono will forward a map to the Board so they will be able to make that decision.

7. PARKS COMMITTEE

Ms. Buono said that Tammy McClure would like to be appointed to the Parks Committee.

Selectman Bailey made a motion to appoint Tammy McClure to the Parks Committee. Motion was seconded by Selectman Pelletier. All were in favor, the motion passed.

8. ADJOURNMENT

Chairman Bailey moved to adjourn at 4:04 p.m. Motion was seconded by Selectman Pelletier. A vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously.
