## Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes April 14, 2021

Present: John P. Stohrer, Chairman, David J. Rogers, Selectman; James C. Bailey III, Selectmen; Dana Brien, Recording Secretary pro-tem.

In Attendance: Mary Morehouse-Rogers, Donna Lovejoy, Mike Lovejoy, David Fullerton, James Rivadeneira, Sara Edie, Scott Yeaton, Joe O'Brien, Ken Matthews, John Segedy, Katherine Charrette, Jon Daley, Cynthia Matthews, Brien Beebe, Linda Noel, Mark Farum, Riché Colcombe, Tori Gelinas, Leigh Bosse.

Chairman Stohrer called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

#### 1. Open Session

David Fullerton: Mr. Fullerton stated his opposition to the proposed noise ordinance and listed other projects such as the boat landing, Beard Brook beach, the sidewalk project, and Grimes Field as projects the Selectmen should be working on.

James Rivadeneira: Mr. Rivadeneira spoke of liking the small town feel of Hillsborough, and in opposition to the noise ordinance.

Joe O'Brien: Mr. O'Brien spoke in support of Noise Ordinance due to inconsiderate neighbor with Monster trucks who revs engines at all hours.

Riché Colcombe: Ms. Colcombe spoke in opposition to the noise ordinance and asked that the Selectmen hold the police department accountable to enforce the noise ordinance that is already in place. Ms. Colcombe also inquired about the Property Maintenance Code that was voted in at the 2019 Town Meeting and which she perceives as not being enforced. She also mentioned website issues that had been brought to Ms. Buono's attention that have not been fixed as yet.

Mary Morehouse-Rogers: Ms. Morehouse-Rogers pointed out that Police Chief Dave Roarick was in agreement with the proposed noise ordinance.

John Segedy: Mr. Segedy requested a list of names of people who requested the work on the noise ordinance specifically from Dave Rogers.

#### 2. Festival Committee re:2021 event

Katherine Charrette and Jon Daley: Ms. Charrette asked what the board's opinion is on holding the summer festival this year. Chairman Stohrer expressed his optimism that the festival could continue. Selectman Bailey referenced the governor's guidance and stated his desire to see it happen. Chairman Stohrer requested a time-line of when a decision needed to be made. Mr. Daley stated that other festivals are already moving forward in NH. Vendors are being sought but are difficult to get without a date in mind. Ms. Colcombe reported the Governor advised to go forward with planning for various events, as he expects things to open up by May 30<sup>th</sup> in his State of the State address. Mr. Daley pointed out that

deposits will be lost if this expectation is not met and the festivals cannot happen. Chairman Stohrer and Selectman Bailey voiced support of moving forward to plan the event. Selectman Rogers also voiced his support but pointed out that consensus is based on information available to this point.

#### 3. Scott Yeaton re: Parks

Mr. Yeaton presented quoted for Grimes Field tennis court crack repair and repair of the park's playground. He asked the Board for guidance on whether to do the crack repair proposal, but Selectman Bailey pointed out that that has been done a number of times and the repair does not last. Chairman Stohrer asked for specifics on what the repair entails. Selectman Bailey suggested living with the problems this year and looking for money to resurface them next year.

Playground equipment Gametime gave a repair quote including replacements and labor of \$23,664.39. Mr. Yeaton stated he has gone through the spare parts we have, and he is of the opinion that there is about a year left before he has to take all the equipment down to keep kids safe. Selectman Bailey expressed concern at the \$10,000.00 labor estimate. Ms. Colcombe pointed out that volunteers put together the playground at the school and Mr. Segedy pointed out that they were under the supervision of the company. Selectman Bailey asked that Mr. Yeaton reach out to the company to see if they are willing to combine volunteer and company labor. Mr. Yeaton stated his concern that the request could delay the project and offered to get more quoted from other companies.

#### 4. Cynthia Matthews re: Presentation of petition

Ms. Matthews and her family presented a written statement which included two exhibits (a and b, attached) and a petition against the noise ordinance.

#### 5. Other Business

#### 2021 Summer Camp.

Chairman Stohrer pointed out the difficulty of having the student employees enforce the guidelines for summer camp. Selectman Bailey concurred. Dates of camp sessions were discussed. Mr. Bosse suggested that the board hold off on making the decision to cancel camp and allow planning to continue. Selectman Rogers pointed out the intermingling of the campers and public at the park. He also pointed out the difficulty of sitting on the fence when the student employees are looking for their summer jobs. Mr. Segedy pointed out that families are in need of solid plans for their summer childcare. Mr. Fullerton agreed with Selectman Rogers that expecting the young employees to handle the ire of members of the public is unreasonable. Ms. Edie pointed out that the school is doing it, and why can't the town at Manahan. Selectman Bailey pointed out that the largest concern it is the public mingling and lifeguard risks. Ms. Gelinas pointed out that the beach could be split in half to allow public use of half of the beach. Selectman Bailey brought up the stipulations of the trust and the requirement to keep the entire park open to the public. Ms. Colcombe challenged that the trust was not written with a pandemic in mind. Ms. Gelinas suggested that members of the public would willingly keep away from the campers if it meant camp could continue. Mr. Rivadeneira voiced his agreement with Ms. Gelinas. Mr. Fullerton suggested port-a-potties and a full-time police detail. Selectman Bailey stated he feels there is not enough information to make a decision at this time.

Chairman Stohrer made a motion to table the decision on summer camp at Manahan, Selectman Bailey seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
