Ms. Buono said that the girl scouts and the high school would also like to set up. Mr. Pinkham will contact all the groups and try and work out a schedule for their fundraising sales.

<u>Comcast</u> – Selectman Brien-Baker said that she has asked Bryan Christianson from Comcast to contact Laura Buono with regard to the franchise agreement between Comcast and the Town of Hillsborough.
