CORRESPONDENCE

- **a.** Ann Poole E-mail expressing concern about roadside mowing. After brief discussion consensus was that the Town's road crew did a good job. Chair Head will send a copy of the State's Best Management Recommendations to Town Administrator Laura Buono to provide to the new Road Agent when hired.
- **b. Viotech LLC,** Henniker St. (M 12, L 75). Richard Head noted what appeared to be some wetlands on the rear of the property. Chair Head will note on the Planning Board's comment sheet that the HCC would like more information about minimizing the impact on wetlands and a storm basin that appears to discharge into wetlands. (After the meeting it was discovered that the two areas in the rear weren't wetlands but some boulders. Chair Head will be adjusting the comments accordingly.)
