Chair Head called the Hillsborough Conservation Commission (HCC) meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Members present: Richard Head, Chair; James McDonough, Vice Chair; Terry Yeaton, Roger Shamel.

MINUTES

a. April 11, 2023

Roger Shamel moved: *To approve the minutes of April 11, 2023.*

James McDonough seconded. Motion Passed 4-0.

CORRESPONDENCE

a. Meridian Land Services, Inc / The Kelley L. DiPietro Revocable Trust – 36
Icehouse Road (M 10, L 60). Minor Impact Standard Dredge & Fill Wetlands Permit Application. The Commission reviewed the application. Consensus was there was no need to comment to the Department of Environmental Services (DES) about the application.

b. New Hampshire Lakes Association (NHLA) – Notification of annual Lakes Congress on June 2.

OLD BUSINESS

a. Confluence Trail - West Main St. (M 11K, L 330-1). Richard Head reported he still needed to complete the wetland application. James McDonough noted the trail markings will need to be updated to more permanent posts.

b. Easement Monitoring – The HCC decided to do its annual monitoring walk of the easement on the Philbrick property on Colby Hill Road (M 3, L 23) on May 14th at 10:00 am.

c. Dues payments – John Segedy reported that the Lakes Association dues were billed in June last year and would likely be again this year. James McDonough & Terry Yeaton reported that the Contoocook & North Branch Rivers Local Advisory Committee was not in need of funding contributions at this time.

NEW BUSINESS

a. Terry Yeaton reported he had been contacted by a citizen interested in finding if the HCC offers Sponsorships for resident youth to attend conservation camps. It was noted that the HCC did do so in the 1970's but hadn't done so in a long time. A question was raised about the ability of the commission to do so. The Commission will consider this at future meetings.

b. Spring Projects – Chair Head asked about projects the Commission would like to work on this year. Consensus was to concentrate on the Confluence trail. Other projects to work on included completion of the possible lot line adjustment of the Old Mill Farm property followed by extension of its trail system and marking.
