CHAPTER 101

BICYCLES

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Special Town Meeting of the Town of Hillsborough 10-2-1958 as Section III of Art 2. Amendments noted where applicable.]

GENERAL REFERENCES

Vehicles and traffic — See Ch. 219.

§ 101-1 License required.

All bicycles used in the Town of Hillsborough shall be licensed by May 1, each year.

§ 101-2 Fee.

The fee for licensing shall be \$0.50.

§ 101-3 Equipment.

No bicycle shall be licensed or operated on the highways unless the same is equipped as follows:

- A. The bicycle shall have a luminous dial or light on the rear and at least 12 square inches of luminous paint on the rear mudguard.
- B. Bicycles ridden at night will have a white light on the front of the bicycle.

§ 101-4 Registration.

Bicycles will be registered at the Town Clerk's office.

§ 101-5 Riding on public sidewalks prohibited.

No bicycles shall be ridden on the public sidewalks or walkways of the town.

§ 101-6 Penalties for offenses.

Any person not complying with this chapter as to bicycle licensing, equipment or operation will be deprived of his bicycle by the Police Department until he has complied with the law.
