CHAPTER 42

LIBRARY TRUSTEES

§ 42-1 Authority to accept and expend unanticipated money.

The town accepts the provisions of RSA 202-A:4-c providing that any town at an Annual Meeting may adopt an article authorizing, indefinitely, until specific rescission of such authority, the public Library Trustees to apply for, accept and expend, without further action by the Town Meeting, unanticipated money from a state, federal or other governmental unit or a private source which becomes available during the fiscal year.

§ 42-2 Authority to accept gifts of personal property.

[Added by the ATM 3-11-1997 by Art. 16]

The town adopts the provisions of RSA 202-A:4-d to authorize the Library Trustees to accept gifts of personal property, other than money, which may be offered to the Library for any purpose; provided, however, that no acceptance of personal property by the Library Trustees shall be deemed to bind the town or the Library Trustees to raise, appropriate or expend any public funds for the operation, maintenance, repair or replacement of such personal property, and such authorization shall remain in effect until rescinded by a vote of Town Meeting
