REGIONAL SOLID WASTE/RESOURCE RECOVERY COOPERATIVE

GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 67-1 Authority to enter agreement; purpose.

The town voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen on behalf of the town to enter into a cooperative agreement, pursuant to RSA 53-A, for the purpose of joining together towns and cities in a joint and cooperative effort for the disposal of solid waste in a manner which will meet federal and state regulations and for the economical and efficient recovery of energy from said solid waste disposal.

§ 67-2 Name of cooperative.

The cooperative to be formed under the cooperative agreement will be designated the "Concord Regional Solid Waste/Resource Recovery Cooperative."

§ 67-3 Copy of agreement.

A copy of the current draft of the proposed cooperative agreement is posted with the warrant and is available at the town offices during normal business hours.

§ 67-4 Authority of Board of Selectmen.

The Board of Selectmen is specifically authorized on behalf of the town to:

- A. Execute and deliver the cooperative agreement (with such changes therein from the posted agreement as the Board of Selectmen shall approve, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by the Board of Selectmen's execution thereof) and such other instruments, documents and agreements as the Board of Selectmen may deem necessary and desirable in furtherance of the purposes of the cooperative agreement.
- B. Cause to be performed all obligations which may from time to time be required pursuant to the terms of the cooperative agreement.
