

Present: Marie Merrow, Russell Galpin, Barbara Cavanaugh, Charles Gaides, Marie Mogavero, Pat Mathison, Dana Brien, Laura Buono (NV) (NV = Non-Voting)

Mrs. Mathison opened the meeting at 1pm.

Minutes: Dr. Gaides made a motion to approve the Minutes from April 11th. Mrs. Cavanaugh seconded. The motion passed.

Mrs. Mathison pointed out a spelling error in Barbara Hays' Name in the fourth paragraph of the minutes from May 6th. Dr. Gaides requested an edit to the second to last paragraph regarding "trips going forward" to add "next year" for clarification. Ms. Merrow moved to approve as corrected, Dr. Gaides seconded. The motion passed.

Mrs. Brien distributed the spreadsheets for tracking expenses and income for SAC. Mr. Galpin moved to accept, Dr. Gaides seconded. The motion passed.

Dr. Gaides brought up the donation of the copier to GHSS by George and Stella Arvenataki. Dr. Gaides feels the SAC budget should be used to pay for the cleaning, service and supplies for the copier. Mrs. Brien stated that, in the future, expenses need to be authorized before they are incurred, by her, if the expense is to come from the SAC account. Mrs. Brien offered to pay for the toner from the SAC budget as that is part of the "Supply" category and money was set aside for it. Ms. Buono advised that the expense be covered by SAC in whole, with the understanding that future expenses should go through Mrs. Brien.

Electricity: Mrs. Mathison asked Ms. Buono for info on the electricity supplier choice process for the Town of Hillsborough. Ms. Buono reported that the Board of Selectmen had discussed the benefits and the costs. No decision has been made as of yet.

Mrs. Mathison suggested that a master list be created for the distribution of the Senior Moments newsletter around town, so that different people are not trying to deliver newsletters to the same distribution point.

Dr. Gaides reported that Terri Paige from State Transportation RCC was at the Deering Selectmen's meeting last week discussing efforts to expand public transportation access around the state. Volunteer Driver Program Flyers were given to her by GHSS representatives at the meeting. She will be at the Hillsborough Selectmen's meeting on June 24th. Dr. Gaides and Mrs. Mogavero hope to discuss a bus from Henniker to Hillsborough, the Volunteer Driver Program's need to have a Handicap vehicle accessible to volunteers for more physically challenged riders, and updating the flyers

Mrs. Mathison reported that the Townwide Yardsale went well, and that a few volunteers from GHSS and SAC will be doing the flower boxes for the Gables and YS building on Friday afternoon with the group that Peter Brigham has put together for community service.

Mr. Galpin moved to close the meeting. Dr. Gaides seconded. The motion passed.

The meeting closed at 2:15pm.
