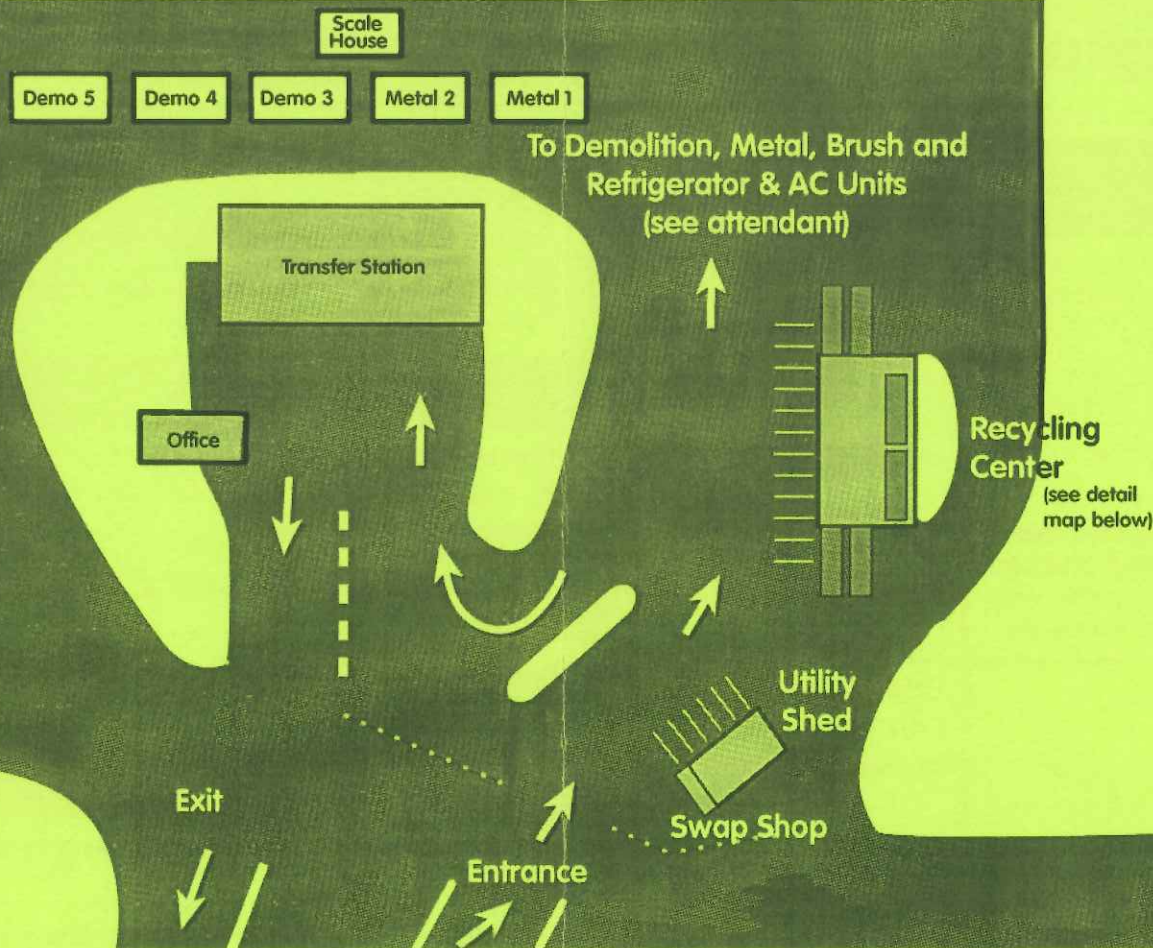



Recycling Station Guide

<p>Container 1A & 1B Commingled Recyclables Tin cans, glass bottles, plastic bottles</p>	
<p>Container 2 Aluminum Soda and beer cans</p>	
<p>Container 3 Cardboard (broken down & flattened)</p>	
<p>Container 4 Paper (packed in paper bags) Newspaper, junk mail, phone books</p>	
<p>Container 5 - Salvation Army Textiles (pack in plastic bags) Clean, dry clothing, drapes, linens, blankets & sheets, shoes, belts, purses</p>	
<p>Container 6 Ni-cad Batteries Rechargeable batteries and lead sinkers</p>	
<p>Container 7 TVs and computer monitors</p>	

Transfer Station Accepts:
Non-recyclable trash in clear bags only
(kitchen waste, toys, diapers, styrofoam,
soiled plastic wrap, etc.) and empty
motor oil containers.

For mattresses and tires (off the rim)
see attendant.

Guidelines for Commingled Recycling

ITEM	WHAT	HOW
CONTAINER 1A & 1B Glass, Plastic, Tin 	<p>GLASS jars and bottles only No light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, or drinking glasses.</p> <p>PLASTIC food containers 1-7 Milk jugs, soda & detergent bottles.</p> <p>TIN cans: pet, tuna, fruit, vegetable, soup, coffee</p> <p>No aluminum foil No aerosol cans No antifreeze jugs No motor oil containers</p> <p>No styrofoam No plastic toys No paint cans No porcelain</p>	Rinse containers. Labels okay.
CONTAINER 2 Aluminum 	Soda and beer cans only. No aluminum foil.	Empty contents. Crushed cans okay, but not required.
CONTAINER 3 Corrugated Cardboard 	Clean double walled corrugated boxes.	Break down flat. Put into bailer.
CONTAINER 4 Paper 	Newspaper, telephone directories, junk mail, catalogs, magazines, school paper notepaper, envelopes (plastic windows okay), stationery, paper bags, white and colored paper, computer paper, paperback books, hardcover books (with covers removed). No boxboard.	Pack into paper grocery bags. No string, tape, etc. Keep clean and dry. Leave on table at paper trailer.

OTHER RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

CONTAINER 5 - Salvation Army
 Textiles: Clean, dry, usable clothing, linens, etc. in sealed, moisture-free plastic bags.

CONTAINER 6
 Rechargeable Ni-cad batteries, lead sinkers.

CONTAINER 7 (A fee applies - see attendant)
 TVs and computer monitors.

UTILITY SHED

Waste Oil - In sealed containers of one gallon or less. Place under shed roof. See attendant if keeping your container.

Auto batteries - Put on pallet at corner of utility building.

Fluorescent tubes - Place tubes in marked boxes under shed roof.

DEMO & YARD WASTE

Construction Demolition - Furniture and building material.

Refrigerators, Freezers & AC Units - Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers.

Note: There is a fee for disposing of the above items. See attendant before going out back.

Metal Pile - No pressurized cylinders (propane, etc.) or automotive gas tanks.

Compost & Yard Waste - This area is for leaves (no sticks), grass clippings, and organic waste.

BRUSH PILE

For brush and clean unpainted wood. No stumps, no pressure treated, no painted or stained wood.
 See attendant first.

Ashes - Place in marked drum at recycling center.
