

CHAPTER 205

SUNDAY ACTIVITIES

[**HISTORY:** Adopted by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Hillsborough 3-8-1932. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 205-1 Sports and games.

It shall be lawful to conduct sports or games, other than horse racing or prize fights in connection with which admission is charged or donations are made or accepted, after 1:00 p.m. of the Lord's Day within the Town of Hillsborough, New Hampshire, but only after license to conduct such a game or sport shall have been granted by the Board of Selectmen and a license fee of \$1 paid for each amateur game and such a fee for each professional game as shall be fixed by said Board of Selectmen.

§ 205-2 Motion pictures, concerts and performances.

It shall be lawful, after 6:00 p.m., for motion pictures, lectures, concerts and dramatic or vaudeville performances to be held on the Lord's Day in Hillsborough in connection with which admission is charged or donations are made or accepted, provided that a special license (Sunday license) shall be obtained from the Board of Selectmen.

§ 205-3 Retail stores.

It shall be lawful for retail stores to conduct their usual and ordinary business on the Lord's Day, provided that a special license is first obtained by the owner thereof, and the fee fixed by the Selectmen is paid.
