OLD BUSINESS

1. Trails

No work reported.

2. Markers

John Segedy reported he had been in contact with Voss Signs regarding trail marker sign. He said he had sent them the art work from the current boundary and easement markers and the charge for setup the first time is probably \$45 (pending review by the art department). Samples and a full catalog are being sent for the Commission to review.

3. Signs

Terry Yeaton reported that he had obtained the news article regarding the Gleason Falls 1968 dedication, copies of which he shared with the Commissioners. He also reported that he and John Segedy met with Laura Buono regarding the Commission's plans for putting up signs at the Commissions properties and easements.

After discussion, the consensus of the Commission was to use wooden signs, to be brown with yellow letters.

Terry Yeaton said he would inquire at Maine Line Graphics about costs.

4. Easement Monitoring

The Commission noted it was getting to be the time of year to do annual monitoring walks.

Commission will discuss at next meeting and set up times to do the Smith and PSNH easements, while Philbrick is usually done in the winter.

Institutional Memory Exercise

John Segedy reported that in reviewing old minutes he discovered that the Sur Realty property purchased last year was not the Commission's first purchase as previously believed, but that the first purchase by the Commission appears to have been the House Rock property.
