Minutes of 12/2/2021 were reviewed: Motion to accept by Sue Durling, seconded by George Arvanetaki, passed unanimously.

LED street light lighting proposal

Brett received proposed contract from Affinity today. Discussion led to decision to table until next meeting to give all a chance to **read it**. New Hampshire Saves rebates may or may not be available by summer, but we should also consider the money that could be saved on utility bills during any delay.

Energy audit

Waiting on ROI numbers from Rich Burns.

Brett attended hearing of the NH House Science, Technology and Energy Committee in Concord and testified in favor of HB 1601, which would improve energy efficiency funding, if passed.

Noted in audit of Town Offices : Buried oil tank. How long has it been there? Should the town consider replacement before any renovations? Tank lifetime is usually 30-40 years; any threat of leaks?

Discussion of the availability of the audit materials to future commissioners or selectboards lead to a discussion of digitizing files.

EV charging
