CHAPTER 142

FUEL OIL

§ 142-1 Applicability.

Note: The Hillsborough Bridge Village Fire Precinct was dissolved by the Annual Town Meeting 3-10-1964, Art. 2. See Ch. 36, Fire Department and Water Department. and for the Town of Hillsborough.

The following regulations are established for Hillsborough Bridge Village Fire Precinct

§ 142-2 Delivery to structures used for habitation; penalties for offenses.

- A. No person shall make a fuel oil delivery of more than 10 gallons' capacity above the lowest (or first) story of any building or structure used for habitation in the Town of Hillsborough.
- B. Penalty for such action shall be a fine of \$20.

§ 142-3 Delivery to structures not used for habitation; penalties for offenses.

- A. No person shall make a fuel oil delivery of more than 60 gallons above the lowest (or first) story of any building or structure not used for habitation in the Town of Hillsborough.
- B. Penalty for such action shall be a fine of \$20.

§ 142-4 Installation of fuel-oil or power burners, penalties for offenses.

Whoever desire to install any fuel-oil or power burner shall first make application to the Chief of the Hillsborough Fire Department and obtain an application accompanied by a fee of \$4. Upon receipt of an application for the installation of an oil (power) burner, the Chief of the Hillsborough Fire Department or his agent shall grant a temporary permit authorizing such installation. Upon completion of the installation, the Chief of the Hillsborough Fire Department or his agent shall inspect, issue or refuse a permit for the storage of oil and the operation of the equipment. Penalty for failure to perform such action shall be a fine of \$20.

§ 142-5 Payment of fees.

All fees shall be payable to the Hillsborough Bridge Village Fire Precinct.

§ 142-6 Effective date.

These regulations shall take effect April 6, 1962
