## **CHAPTER 30**

## **DEFENSE AND INDEMNIFICATION**

*Note: The provisions of RSA 31:106 are as follows.* 

"31:106 Indemnification; Civil Rights Suits. All cities, towns, counties, village districts and precincts, school districts, supervisory unions and other municipal corporations and political subdivisions shall indemnify and save harmless any person employed by it and any member or officer of its governing board, administrative staff or agencies including but not limited to selectmen, school board members, city councilors and aldermen, town and city managers and superintendents of schools from personal financial loss and expense including reasonable legal fees and costs, if any, arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reason of any act or omission constituting a violation of the civil rights of an employee, teacher or student or any other person under any federal law if such act or omission was not committed with malice, and if the indemnified person at the time of such act or omission was acting within the scope of his employment or office."

## § 30-1 Adoption of statutory provisions.

The town voted to adopt the provisions of RSA 31:105 and thereby indemnify and save harmless town employees or agents from claims arising out of their employment with the town.
